The Government of Telangana has instituted State Awards to recognize the contributions of exceptional teachers working in Universities and Affiliated Colleges across the State. These awards are presented annually on Teachers' Day, 5th September, and include a Certificate of Merit, Shawl, Gold-plated Silver Medal, and a Cash Prize of ₹10,000 (Rupees Ten Thousand only).

In accordance with the Government Orders cited above, specific guidelines have been issued for the selection process. The number of awards allotted to each University is determined as follows:

Number of Teachers in the University	Number of Awards
Less than 100	One
100-200	Two (including one for a teacher below 40 years of age)
More than 200	One per hundred or part thereof (including two for the 'Young' teachers below 40 years of age)

The University-Level Committee, headed by the Vice Chancellor and comprising at least two Deans or Principals of Constituent Colleges, is requested to examine nominations forwarded by Deans, Principals, or Heads of Departments. Nominations should be submitted in the prescribed formats:

- **Annexure IIA** for State Universities (including BRAOU, NIMS, NALSAR, JNTU, JNAFAU, SPTU, and KNRUHS)
- **Annexure IIB** for Agricultural and Horticultural Universities
- **Annexure IIC** for Veterinary University

You are requested to ensure that only genuinely deserving teachers who meet the eligibility criteria are recommended. Each University is expected to forward at least **three** nominations per award category for consideration by the State-Level Committee.

The completed nominations must reach the Office of the Commissioner of Collegiate Education, Nampally, Hyderabad, by **18 August 2026**.
